WEEKLY DEVAR TORAH

'And the children struggled within her, and she said, "If [it be] so, why am I [like] this?"...And the Lord said to her, "Two nations are in your womb, and two kingdoms will separate from your innards, and one kingdom will become mightier than the other kingdom, and the elder will serve the younger."' (Gen. 25:22-23)

Commentaries say that Rivka was unaware that she was carrying twins; she thought the turmoil within her existed in a single baby – THIS had her very upset; she was somewhat calmed by the Divine message of her carrying twins.

Another commentator suggests that Rivka knew she'd have twins but did not see the benefit of bringing a Yaakov into this world if it meant also having an Eisav. Part of the reply to her question "why do I need this?" is that her conclusion was wrong.

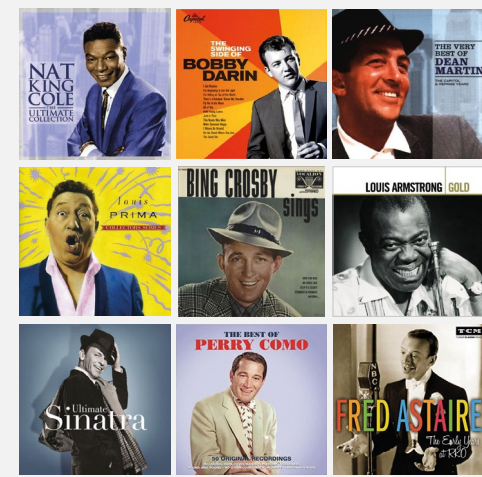
