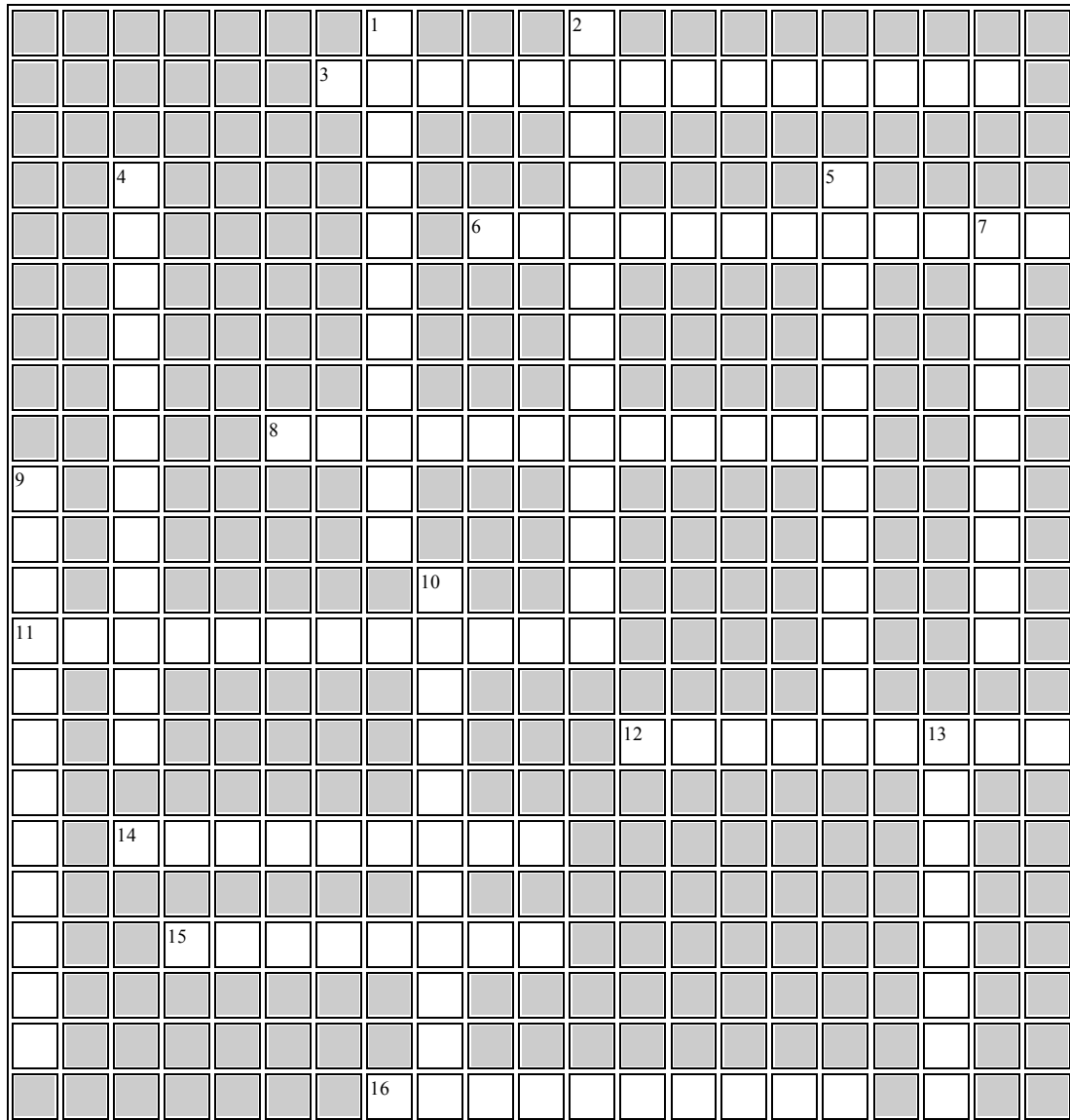


Choral Crossword
